DUTIES

The Teacher of Art provides instruction to students in grades Kindergarten through 12 in a major urban school district with a racially and ethnically integrated student population; implements the art curriculum; assumes responsibility for materials and supplies; keeps abreast of new methodologies and trends, teaching strategies, and techniques; and performs related work as required.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS

Each applicant must:

1. present a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Instructional Certificate in Art, or a letter from a certification officer stating that all course work leading to such certification will be completed within 90 days from the date of application,
OR
2. present a Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Intern Certificate in Art or a letter from a certification officer stating that the applicant will be issued an Intern Certificate within 90 days from the date of application,
OR
3. present a current instructional certificate in Art from a state other than Pennsylvania. **If you are not certified in Pennsylvania, you should immediately contact the Bureau of Teacher Preparation and Certification to begin the evaluation process at: 333 Market Street, Harrisburg, PA 17126-0333, or by phone at: 717-787-3356.**

IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THIS POSITION, YOU MUST ATTACH TO YOUR APPLICATION, A COPY OF YOUR CERTIFICATE OR AN ORIGINAL LETTER FROM A CERTIFICATION OFFICER, AND TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION FROM SUPERVISORY PERSONNEL WHO HAVE DIRECT KNOWLEDGE OF YOUR QUALIFICATIONS.

HIRING REQUIREMENT

ALL CANDIDATES MUST PRESENT, AT THE TIME OF HIRING, A VALID PENNSYLVANIA CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK, A COMPLETED PENNSYLVANIA CHILD ABUSE CHECK, AN APPROVED PHYSICAL EXAMINATION, YOUR ORIGINAL PENNSYLVANIA TEACHER CERTIFICATE, OR TWO SEPARATE SEALED COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS WITH RAISED SEALS, AN FBI CLEARANCE. SELECTION PROCEDURE

Qualified applicants will participate in a screening process which includes an essay evaluation, interview, reference checks and portfolio review

PART I: ORAL EXAMINATION

An oral examination will evaluate the candidate's knowledge of principals, practices, and techniques of teaching as well as those personal characteristics related to success in the position.

Minimum Required score: 80.00

Weight: 50%

PART II: PRACTICAL EXAM

At the qualifying portfolio review the candidate is required to present a portfolio of six (minimum) to eight (maximum) original pieces of his/her own recent art work. The portfolio must be professionally presented, that is, matted or framed, and should include two dimensional art and, at the candidate's option, small examples of three dimensional arts or crafts. The portfolio should reflect a variety of concepts and demonstrate the candidate's ability to execute art work in a variety of techniques and media. It should include representational images and observations from life.

Minimum Required score: 80.00

Weight: 50%

APPOINTMENT

The names of Pennsylvania certified candidates who are successful in the School District's screening process will be forwarded to the Office of Professional Staffing for appointment activity.

If a certificate is required for this position, all candidates must present the original of the required certificate at the time of hiring. Failure to present any required documents will result in the candidate's being passed over for hiring.

If the hiring of a bilingual candidate best meets the needs of a school or work location, the School District of Philadelphia reserves the right to give priority to the hiring of bilingual candidates. Current School District of Philadelphia needs for bilingual appointments include applicants who speak fluent English and fluent Spanish, Vietnamese, Chinese, or Russian. The hiring of all bilingual candidates will be preceded by the satisfactory completion of a language proficiency screening process in the qualifying languages.

Five additional score points will be added to the scores of those candidates who are currently long term substitute teachers with the School District of Philadelphia on step 6 or higher of the long term substitute salary schedule by the first day of the selection process if they receive a final passing score.

Five additional score points will be added to the examination scores of those candidates who have successfully completed their student teaching in a School District of Philadelphia school if they receive a final passing score.

Three additional score points will be added to the scores of those candidates who have successfully completed the Philadelphia Urban Seminar offered by Indiana University of Pennsylvania. Candidates must attach a transcript from Indiana University showing this course or a letter from the Dean of Indiana University stating that they have successfully completed this seminar. Applicants who are eligible for points for either long term substitute or student teaching experience with the School District of Philadelphia are not eligible for these seminar points. VETERANS PREFERENCE

The Veterans Preference Act, 51 P.S. § 7101 et seq. provides persons who meet the definition of "soldier" under the Act to preference in hiring. Pursuant to the Act, five points will be added to the passing scores of qualified candidates. In order to qualify under the definition of "soldier," the individual must have been honorably discharged and either:

1. have served in any capacity in the armed forces of the United States since July 27, 1953; or
2. have served during a war or armed conflict prior to July 27, 1953; or
3. be the widow or widower of a "soldier"; or
4. be the spouse of a disabled "soldier."

Candidates who wish to assert Veterans' Preference should attach a copy of their DD214 or their spouse's DD214 and supporting documents to their application. Candidates asserting Veterans Preference must present their **original** DD214 at the time of hiring. Failure to do so will result in being denied Veterans Preference. Persons asserting the preference will still be subject to all other conditions of School District employment.

CONDITION OF SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOYMENT

NEW EMPLOYEES MUST SHOW PROOF OF AMERICAN CITIZENSHIP OR PROOF OF LEGAL RESIDENCE IN THE UNITED STATES AS A CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT WITH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF PHILADELPHIA.

IF YOU ARE HIRED AS A PROVISIONAL EMPLOYEE, YOU MUST SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THE SELECTION PROCESS IN ORDER TO CONTINUE YOUR EMPLOYMENT WITH THE DISTRICT AND TO ACCRUE PROPER SENIORITY.

Please note that an employee's attendance, punctuality and performance are important factors to be considered in the selection procedure. Applicants who have been subjected to disciplinary action or who have documented records of unsatisfactory work performance may not be appointed.

SECTION 8-301

Section 8-301 of the City Home Rule Charter states that:

"Except as otherwise provided in this Charter, no person shall hold more than one office or position of profit, whether elective or appointive, under the City and no such person shall hold such office or position while holding any other office or position of profit in or under the government of the United States, of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or any ex office held by virtue of another office or position."
